#### **OUTCOMES ACHIEVED**

- Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on 13 August 2015
- Academic Audit of the session 2014-15 was conducted. It was found that the general result was satisfactory. Some courses like B.Com. 6, BBA 5, B.Sc. Biotech. 6, M.Sc. Physics 3 recorded 100% pass percentage which was appreciated. But B.A. 1, M.A. Skt. 1, M.A. Eng. 1, M.A. Eco. 1 reported very low pass percentage. They were asked to address the issue.

- The college organized two National Level Conferences in this session.
